

## DRIVER EDUCATION INFORMATION

Driver Education classes for the 2010-2011 school year:

Class starting dates are subject to change based on School Calendar events.

Each high school has a Driver Education program. Students may register in the front office during the registration dates posted above. Students are selected chronologically by birthdates. We decide how many students are needed to fill the session and then invite students and parents to a meeting to explain how to obtain a permit and pay the fee. The cost is \$95 for the class and a fee of \$21.50 to purchase the permit. Students must have a certified copy of birth certificate with the stamped seal on it to purchase the permit. Be sure you have this birth certificate before you sign up. NO photocopies of the birth certificate are allowed. Students must be at least 14 ½ years of age to enroll in class.

Canyon Ridge High School runs their classes from 6:45-7:45 a.m. 4-5 days a week for 7 weeks. Classes are held in room 301.

Twin Falls High School runs their classes from 7:00-8:00 a.m. 4-5 days a week for 7 weeks. Classes are held in room S2.

Driving times are scheduled by the instructor, usually after school and on the weekends.

Students are allowed only 2 absences, 3 tardies equal on absence. Students are graded on the classroom, driving and attitude. Students must pass all 3 areas to pass the course.
